2. To serve as a volunteer advisory body whose purpose is to solicit student, parent, educators and community input in an appropriate, convenient and meaningful manner, receive community input, advice and make recommendations from the community's perspectives in matters pertaining to educational justice, the most significant Civil Right remaining to be achieved, for African American students and families.
3. To foster and develop, through dialogue, workshops, political and civil action, and other appropriate means, an awareness of the consequences of educational under achievement in every corner of society.
4. To develop the talents and skills of committee members and other interested persons to engage in social activities designed to foster the foregoing purposes of the organization as limited by the laws and seek to subsidize such activities.
5. To use its collective expertise and knowledge, considering multiple perspectives to advise and make recommendations relating to educational civil rights to all parts of society.
